

Using with the Bluetooth-enabled PDA

You can use the i-PHONO mini headphone's stereo (A2DP) and remote control (AVRCP) functions with the Bluetooth-enabled PDA which answers the following requirements:

- Microsoft® Windows Mobile™ 2003 Second Edition or later
- Windows Media Player 9 or later
- Both Bluetooth hardware (embedded chipset) and software (stack) support A2DP (Advanced Audio Distribution Profile) and AVRCP (Audio Video Remote Control Profile)

Please turn on the Bluetooth radio of your PDA and put the i-PHONO mini headphone in the pairing mode (page.20) beforehand.

Step-1: Open “Bluetooth Manager” and tap “High Quality Audio setup”.

Step-2: An icon named “iPHONO mini” will appear. Tap this icon.

Step-3: When the PDA discovers the i-PHONO mini headphone for the first time, you may be prompted for a passkey. Enter **0000** (a sequence of four zeros) and tap “OK”.

Step-4: Check “Create a shortcut for this connection” and tap “Finish”.

Step-5: Once the headphone has made an initial pairing with the PDA, the High Quality Audio shortcut icon for i-PHONO mini headphone will appear on the screen of PDA. If the High Quality Audio connection is established via Bluetooth A2DP, the shortcut icon will be marked with a Green symbol.

Thereafter, you only need to double tap the shortcut icon to reestablish the High Quality Audio connection.

Step-6: After the High Quality Audio connection is established, you can use the i-PHONO mini headphone to listen to the stereo music played from the connected PDA. Open “Windows Media Player” and select music files to play.

Besides, you can remote control the music playing from the connected i-PHONO mini headphone. Please consult the following chart to operate the headphone’s Remote Control Roller and Power/Call Button to do the available functions.

Player Function	Remote Control Roller
Volume Up / Down	Roll Up / Down
Next	Roll Up & Hold 2 sec.
Rewind or Previous	Roll Down & Hold 2 sec.
Play / Pause	Press Once

Player Function	Power/Call Button
Stop	Press Once

Notice:

- The Bluetooth software and stacks you used must support Bluetooth A2DP and AVRCP.
- The remote control functions can be applied to Windows Media Player 9 or later versions and might be unavailable for other media application programs.
- The actual “Rewind” and “Previous” functions may vary due to the different Windows Media Player versions and the diverse Bluetooth devices.
- The music streaming may be interrupted or interfered if another Bluetooth device is connected with the PDA at the same time. Only connect the headphone with the PDA can keep the music streaming quality.
- If the headphone is distant from the PDA, or if there are some metal obstructions in-between, the music streaming may be interrupted or interfered.
